For almost five decades, PT Freeport Indonesia (PTFI) has contributed to national and local economic growth and become a strategic partner of Indonesia. PTFI has invested US\$ 18 billion to date, including US\$ 11 billion for Underground Development and contributed more than US\$ 71 billion to the National Gross Domestic Product since 1992

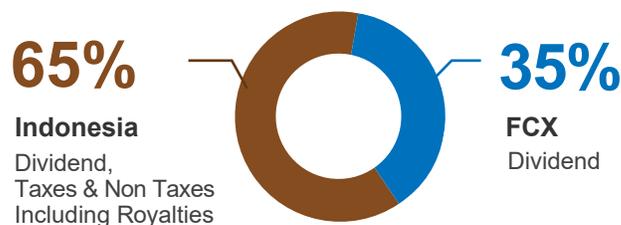
