


# Community Development



When PT Freeport Indonesia (PTFI) began its operations, the population of Mimika was less than 1,000 people. Today, the population has grown to 318,679, making Mimika as the region with highest migration rate in Indonesia. To this day, PTFI remains the main driver of economy in Papua
