### **80th Anniversary of Indonesian Independence, Freeport Realizes the World's Largest Integrated Copper Mining**

**Tembagapura, August 17, 2025** - PT Freeport Indonesia (PTFI) conducted the Red and White Flag Raising Ceremony to commemorate the 80th Anniversary of the Independence of the Republic of Indonesia simultaneously at six work locations across three provinces: Central Papua, East Java, and DKI Jakarta.

The theme "Integrated Upstream-Downstream Mining" unified the ceremony at PTFI's Tembagapura area, which began at 09:00 WIT/07:00 WIB, concurrent with ceremonies in Kuala Kencana Mimika Regency, Nabire Regency, PTFI Smelter and PT Smelting in Gresik Regency, and PTFI's Jakarta office. This illustrates that PTFI has been operating in an integrated manner from upstream to downstream, from mining and processing in Tembagapura to refining processes at the Gresik Smelter in East Java.

The commemoration of Indonesia's Independence Day has become a tradition at Freeport Indonesia, held more than 50 times since operations began in 1973. This year's ceremony was led by PTFI President Director Tony Wenas, attended by nearly three thousand participants

"On September 23, 2024, by the grace of God and with full support from the government and all stakeholders, President Joko Widodo officially inaugurated the production of the world's largest single-line Copper Smelter. Subsequently, on March 17, 2025, President Prabowo Subianto inaugurated the operation of the Precious Metals Refinery built at the PTFI Smelter location in Gresik, East Java. This demonstrates how important PTFI's presence and the downstream integration being carried out, are for the country," said PTFI President Director Tony Wenas.

Following the solemn flag-raising ceremony, the 80th Independence Day celebration at PTFI was enlivened with a colossal dance performance by 500 PTFI employees from Papua to Gresik and Jakarta. The theme of this colossal dance was "Moving Together from Upstream to Downstream for Advanced Indonesia," which depicts the journey of copper, starting from mining upstream to processing downstream.

"This dance carries a message from the Central Papua Highlands where copper mineral mining is conducted upstream, and flows downstream to the copper refinery in Gresik, East Java, providing benefits for Papua and Indonesia," said Tony.

PTFI, as the world's largest integrated copper mining company from upstream to downstream, joins in celebrating the 80th Independence Day of Indonesia. Throughout August, PTFI organized various activities that channeled the spirit of nationalism and mutual cooperation from upstream in Papua—including Tembagapura, Kuala Kencana, and Nabire—to downstream in Gresik and Jakarta. The festivities of the 80th Independence Day from upstream to downstream are an expression of gratitude for Indonesia's independence.

"I congratulate all members of the Freeport Indonesia family in Tembagapura, Kuala Kencana,
