Freeport Commemorates National OSH Month, Delivers Safety and Health Messages Simultaneously at Three Work Locations

Jakarta, January 22, 2026 – PT Freeport Indonesia President Director Tony Wenas, in observance of the 2026 National Occupational Safety and Health Month (BK3N), emphasized that all employees at Freeport's three work locations should make safety and health the primary foundation in every aspect of life.

"The commemoration of the 2026 National Occupational Safety and Health Month (BK3N) is not merely fulfilling a national mandate. It is also a reflection of our commitment to making occupational safety and health the primary foundation in every PTFI operation," said Tony Wenas while opening the 2026 PTFI BK3N series at the PTFI Smelter in Gresik, East Java, on Monday, January 12, 2026.

Tony explained that safety is the main pillar of PTFI's corporate values, namely SINCERE (Safety, Integrity, Commitment, Excellence, Respect). Safety is not only about operations, but safety is paramount for all PTFI employees. "Safety starts from home, not just the workplace. Safety starts with me, it begins with ourselves," he said.

Meanwhile, from Kuala Kencana, PTFI Chief Mining Engineer Carl Tauran emphasized to employees that "no matter how small the work, nothing is more important than safety. Let us make this OSH month the beginning of a commitment that continues throughout the year."

The opening of the BK3N commemoration series took place in Tembagapura and Kuala Kencana in Central Papua Province, as well as at the Smelter in Gresik, East Java. BK3N 2026 carries the theme "*Building a Professional, Reliable, and Collaborative National Mining Safety Management Ecosystem*" with the spirit of "*Rise Together, Work Safely, Work Healthy*." This series will run for one month.

The 2026 BK3N commemoration at PTFI's three work areas is filled with various educational, competitive, and participatory activities. These diverse activities include safety campaigns conducted in work areas and communities such as schools and campuses, safety competitions such as first aid and Automated External Defibrillator (AED), fatal risk management challenges, safety reporting, safety innovation, safety videos, and safety quizzes. In addition, a 50-kilometer virtual run competition in Gresik and a 68-kilometer virtual run in Tembagapura and Kuala Kencana will take place during this year's BK3N commemoration.

Through this series of activities, PTFI encourages the improvement of competence, awareness, and concern of all levels of company members regarding occupational safety and health aspects, as an integrated mining company from upstream to downstream.

The peak event of BK3N at PTFI will take place in Tembagapura on February 7, 2026, with activities including city cleanup, safety games, fire extinguishing simulations, and local music performances. Meanwhile, the overall closing ceremony of BK3N 2026 will take place on February 14, 2026, in Kuala Kencana.
